

**Franklin Road Christian School Internet User Agreement – 2005-2006**  
**Consent Form for Users/Parents/Guardians**  
**Students in grades 4-12**

Internet access is available to students and teachers at Franklin Road Christian School (FRCS). The Internet is an electronic “highway” connecting thousands of computers and millions of individual subscribers all over the world and is coordinated through a complex association of government agencies and networks. Access to the Internet offers vast, diverse and unique resources to both students and teachers. Our goal in providing this service is to promote educational excellence in school by facilitating resource sharing, innovation, and communication. On a global network, however, it is impossible to control all materials, and an industrious user may discover controversial material, *even with the protection of the Internet content filters on the FRCS network*. The smooth operation of the network relies upon the proper conduct of the end users who must adhere to strict guidelines. All Internet traffic is monitored. The system tracks user activity and which sites each user visits. Attempts to bypass the filtering software also generate warnings to the system administrator. These guidelines are provided here so that you are aware of the responsibilities you are about to acquire. If a user violates any of these provisions, future access could be denied. Possible school disciplinary action and/or legal action could also result. The signature(s) at the end of this document is (are) legally binding and indicate(s) the party (parties) who signed this agreement has (have) read the terms and conditions carefully and understand(s) their significance.

**User Guidelines**

1. Use of the Internet must be in support of education and research and consistent with the educational objectives of FRCS. Any downloading of files (including sounds, pictures, videos, etc.) must be for the sole purpose of classroom work and/or projects. Downloading of executable files is prohibited. Transmission of any material in violation of any federal or state law or regulation is prohibited. Use for commercial activities is prohibited unless prior written consent from the superintendent has been granted.
2. FRCS does not warrant that the functions of the system will meet any specific requirements you may have, or that it will be error free or uninterrupted; nor shall it be liable for any direct or indirect, incidental, or consequential damages (including lost data and information) sustained or incurred in connection with the use, operation or inability to use the system.
3. Any action by a user that is determined by the system administrators to constitute an inappropriate use of the Internet or to improperly restrict or inhibit other members from using and enjoying the Internet is strictly prohibited and may result in termination of privileges. The user specifically agrees not to submit, publish or display on the Internet any defamatory, inaccurate, abusive, obscene, profane, sexually oriented, threatening, racially offensive, or illegal material.
4. Use of any information obtained via the Internet is at your own risk. FRCS specifically denies any responsibility for the accuracy or quality of information obtained through the Internet, and it exercises no control whatsoever over the content of the information residing on or passing through the system.
5. Vandalism shall result in cancellation of privileges. Vandalism includes any malicious attempt to harm, destroy or alter data on the Internet or software or hardware used to access, store, or print such information. Any attempt to access restricted data will also result in termination of privileges.
